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### Accurate data reporting is critical...


**CALPADS**

- FALL 1 reports your Unduplicated Pupil Count (UPC)**
  - Meal Applications must all be collected, verified
  - Census Day data submitted in December
- Potential for error**
  - Not collecting all applications
  - Not verifying –on time!
  - Data entry errors
  - Missing direct certification data
  - CALPADS-SIS reporting issues

**What if you underreport by 40 free/reduced eligible students out of 300 eligible students with 400 enrolled?**

- UPC rate reduced by 10%
- Reduce your LCFF rate by \$80/ADA OR loss of \$32,000

Note: Actual impact will vary by LCFF implementation, grade levels, etc.



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...accurate reporting is critical for attendance too!

**Average Daily Attendance (ADA)**

1. **Period 2 (P-2) report sets your ADA total for the year:** this represents the first 7 or 8 months' average daily attendance
2. **Attendance must be taken daily and accurately:** a single day missed throws off your whole report

**What if you underreport by just 5 ADA?**

- Reduce your funding by 5X your LCFF rate
- Example LCFF rate of \$9,500 – total loss of \$47,500




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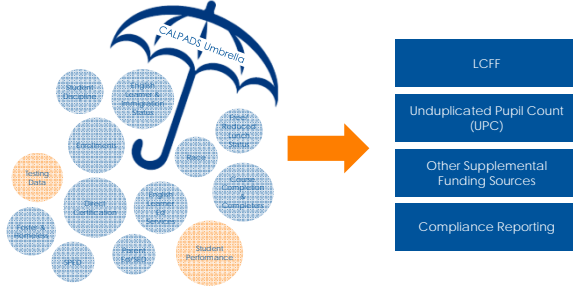

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CALPADS: Our example

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**What is CALPADS? California Longitudinal Pupil Achievement Data System**

- **CALPADS is the data source for state and federal accountability reporting**
  - Unduplicated Pupil Count, and EL and FRPM for supplemental funding
  - Direct certification for free lunch eligibility (state-level monthly match)
  - Foster Youth (state-level weekly match)
  - TOMS (Testing Operations Management System) for SBAC/CAASPP
- **The system collects**
  - student enrollment,
  - demographic,
  - program participation,
  - course enrollment and completion,
  - discipline,
  - certificated staff, and
  - statewide assessment data (in-progress)
- **Data are used to track students over time (continuously enrolled)**
- **Fulfill state and federal reporting requirements (and some authorizers')**
- **Provide information about students and schools to state decision-makers, parents, community and researchers**

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### Common CALPADS Issues

- Staff do not have the right skill set to
  - Understand your local system (SIS)
  - Understand data and reporting requirements
  - Coordinate and communicate
  - Troubleshoot SIS or CALPADS issues
  - Self-direct
- Staff are not trained
- Responsibilities and expectations are not clearly established
- Data collection and entry are an afterthought
- Single points of failure
- Staff do not have the time to keep up with all of the changes

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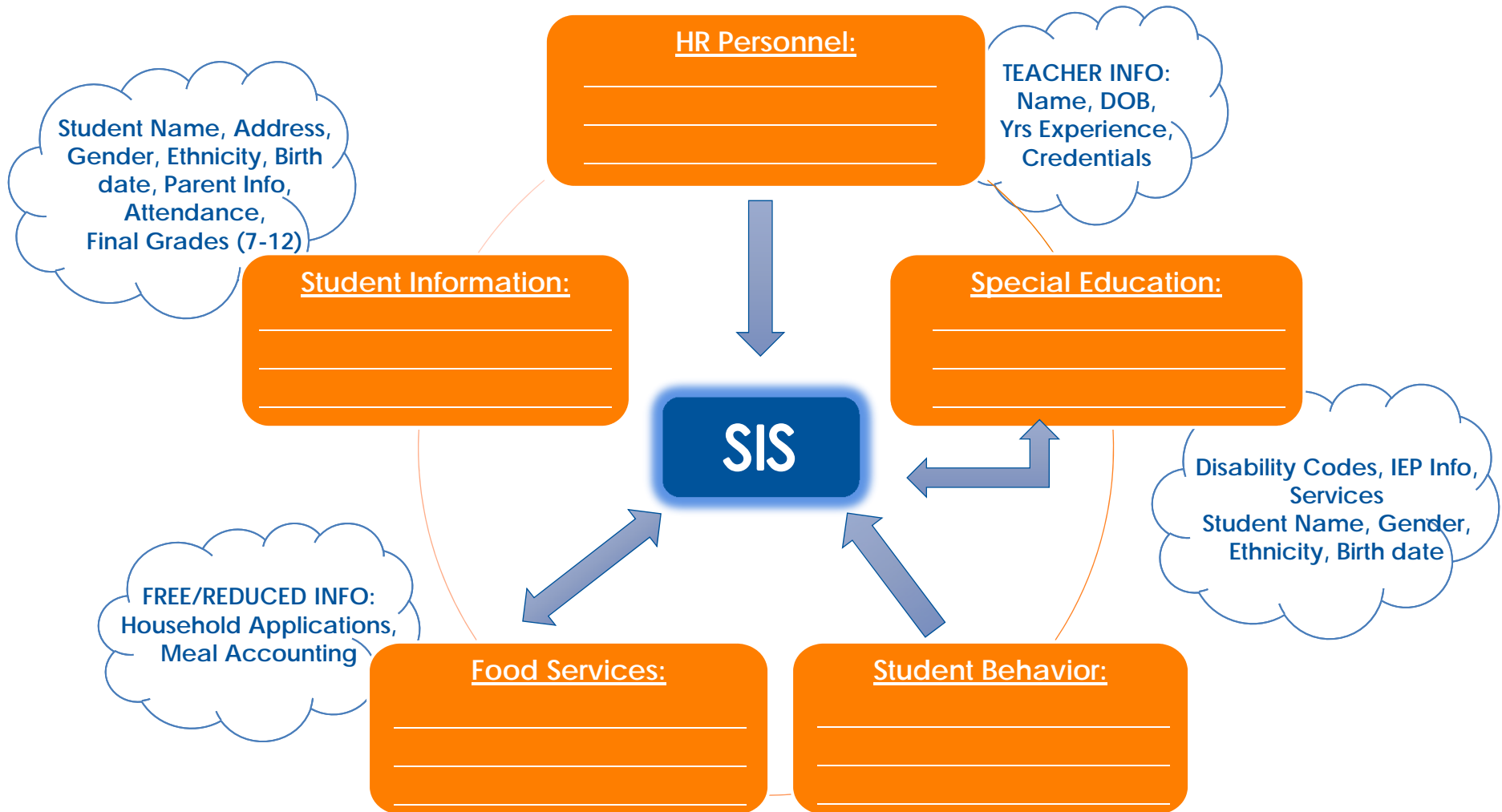
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# CALPADS Data Management: Who has our data?



Let's think...

- Now that we know who has our data, how often do they check in with each other?
  - HR/Personnel (Staff data) → SIS point person
  - SPED team (Program data) → SIS point person
  - Student Information (Enrollment and demographic data) → SIS point person
  - Student Behavior → SIS point person
  - Food Services (Free and reduced lunch) → SIS point person
  - Foster and Homeless → SIS point person
  - SIS point person → School leadership
- Are the check-ins in alignment with our reporting calendar?



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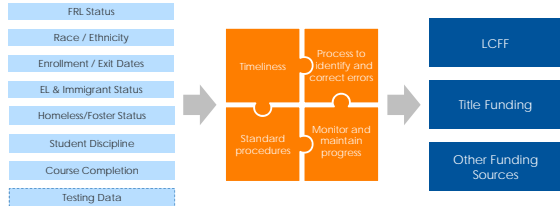

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CALPADS management, aligns with all school revenue compliance practices

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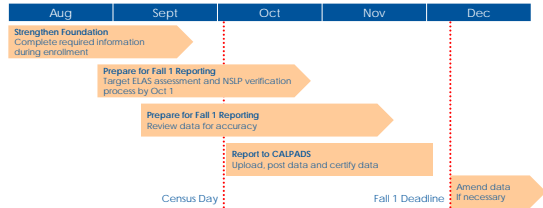

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Unduplicated Pupil Count (often spoken in %) focus is early, ongoing data management and reporting

Day	Date	Task Completed
No less than two (2) weeks prior to the first day of school		All employee data is in our SIS. Clearances are complete.
First day of school		All student data is in our SIS.
Day ____		All students are enrolled in course sections
Day 14 (Fall 1)		All student enrollments in CALPADS
Day 20 (PENSEC/LAUSD)		All enrollments up-to-date in SIS for 20-day reporting
Day 30 (Fall 2/NSLP/ELAS)		FRL program eligibility transitions, CELDT IA complete
Day ____		No changes to section enrollments in first term courses
Day ____	October 1, 2016	Begin NSLP verification
Day ____	October 5, 2016	CALPADS Census Day
Day ____	October 30, 2016	CBEDS deadline
Day ____	Mid-December	Fall 1 submission deadline
Day ____	Early March	Fall 2 Submission Deadline



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**Best Practices**

- Reporting requirements (and data points) are understood
- Successful Reporting requires Collaboration
  - Required data crosses the LEA
  - Subject matter expertise is required
- Data Owners are Accountable
- Data Management Calendar is Established
- Responsibilities are Established
- Staff are Trained

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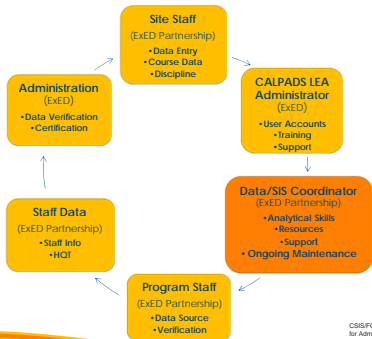
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ExED's CALPADS Collaboration Wheel



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
