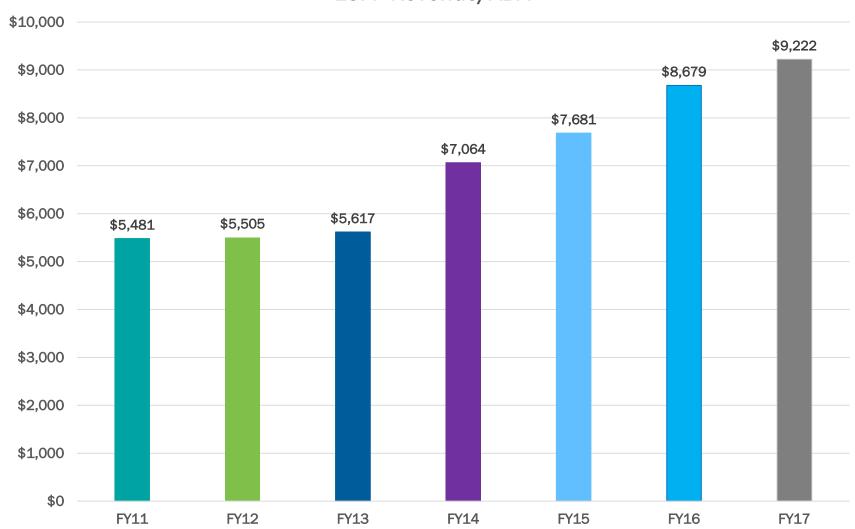


Revenue: 7-year trends

LCFF Revenue/ADA

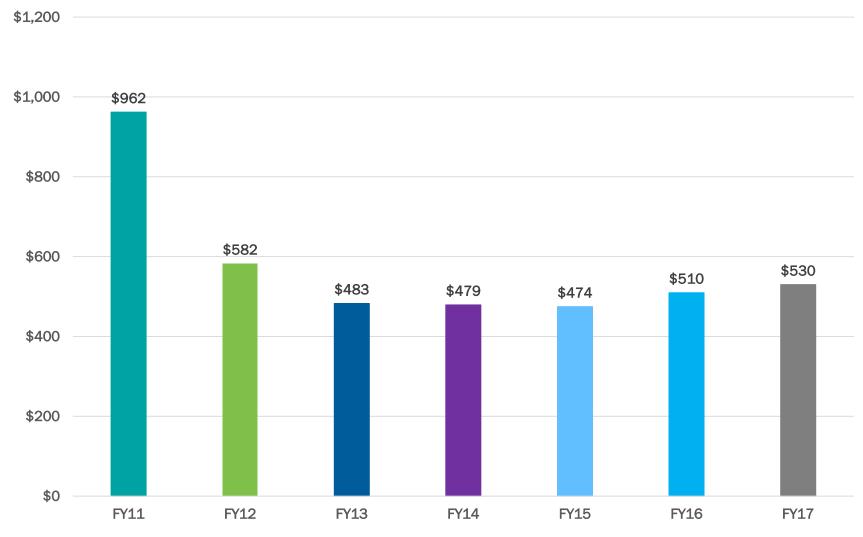


Revenue: 7-year trends (cont.)



Decreasing federal revenue



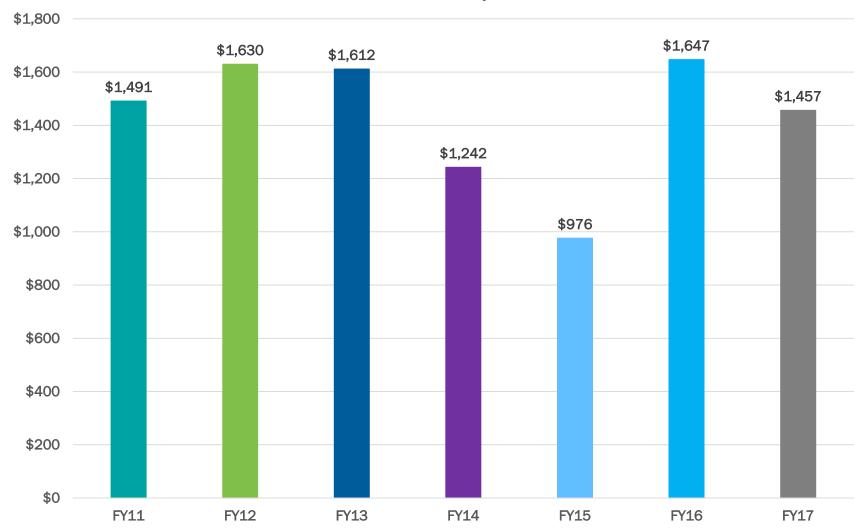


Revenue: 7-year trends (cont.)

Slight decline in local funding

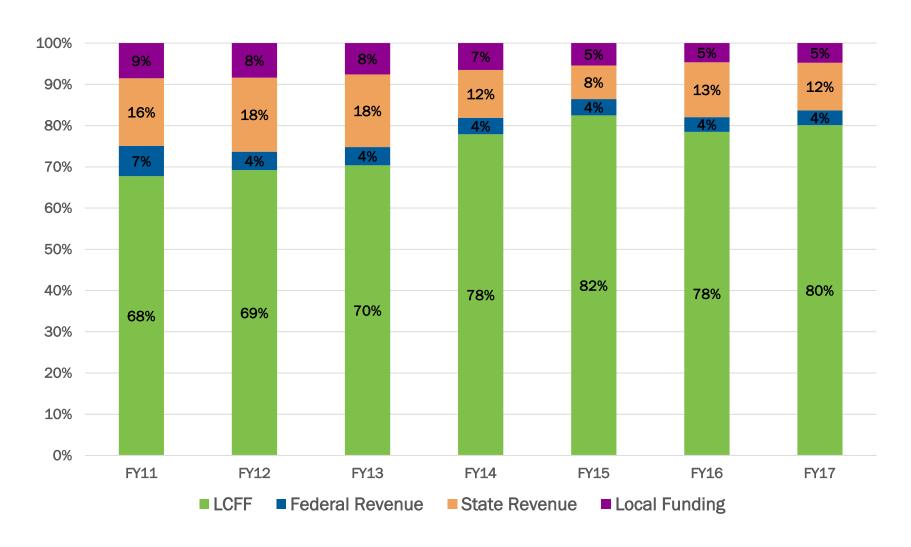




Percentage of funding over time

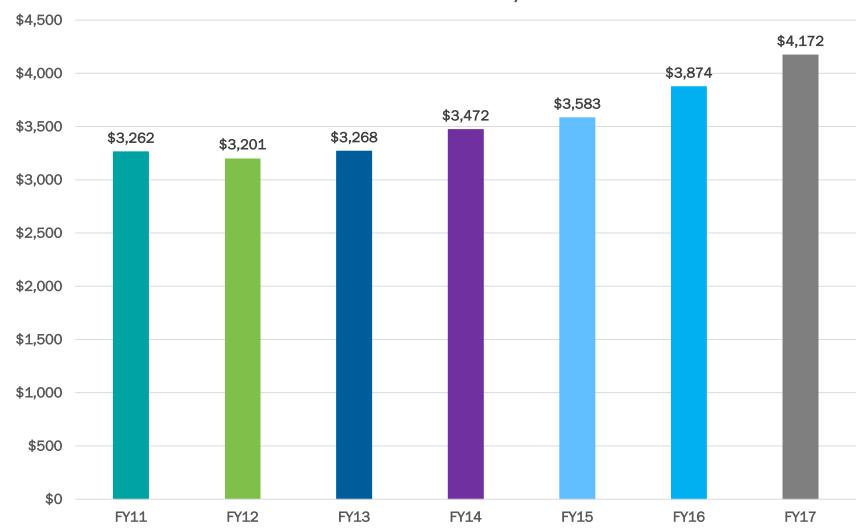


Expenses: 7-year trends



Spending on certificated salaries increasing

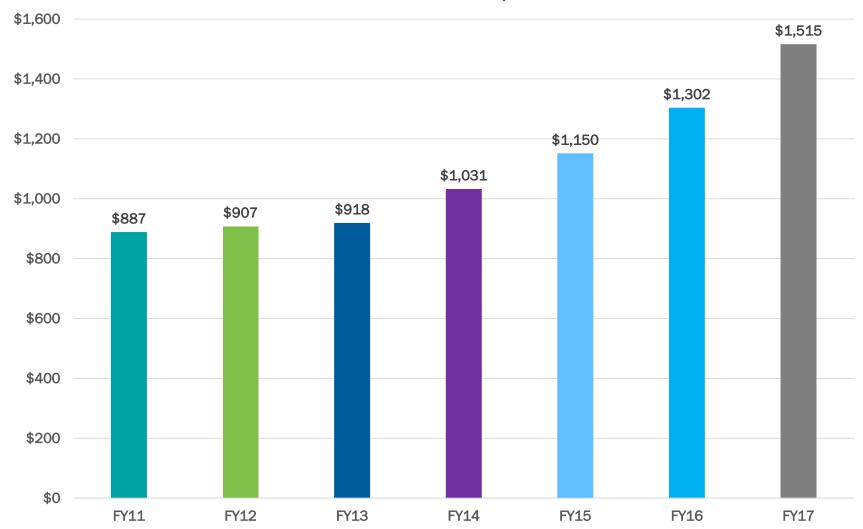






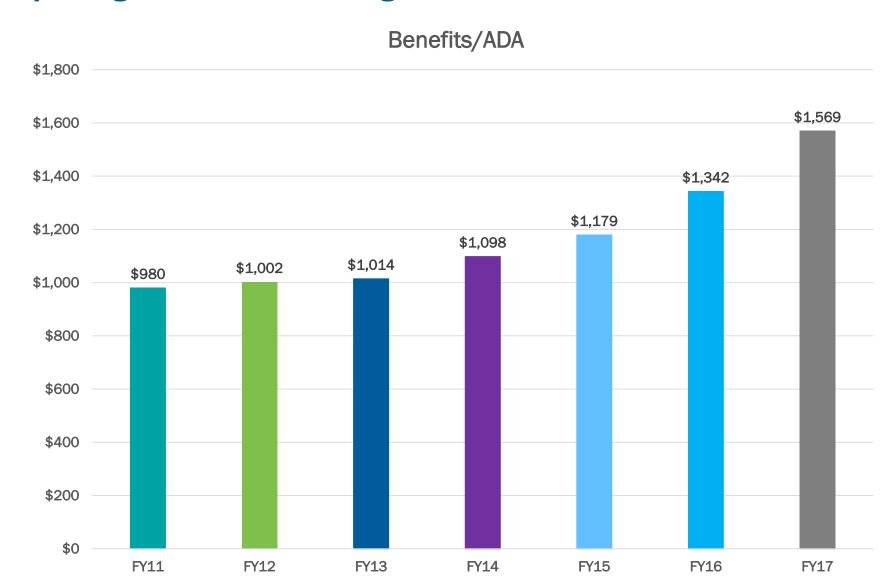
Spending on classified salaries almost doubled

Classified Salaries/ADA



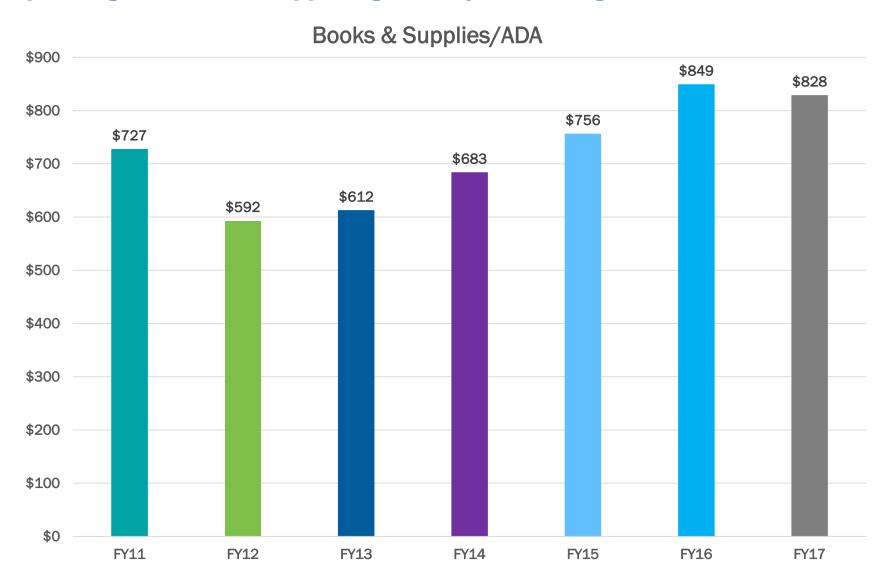


Spending on benefits increasing





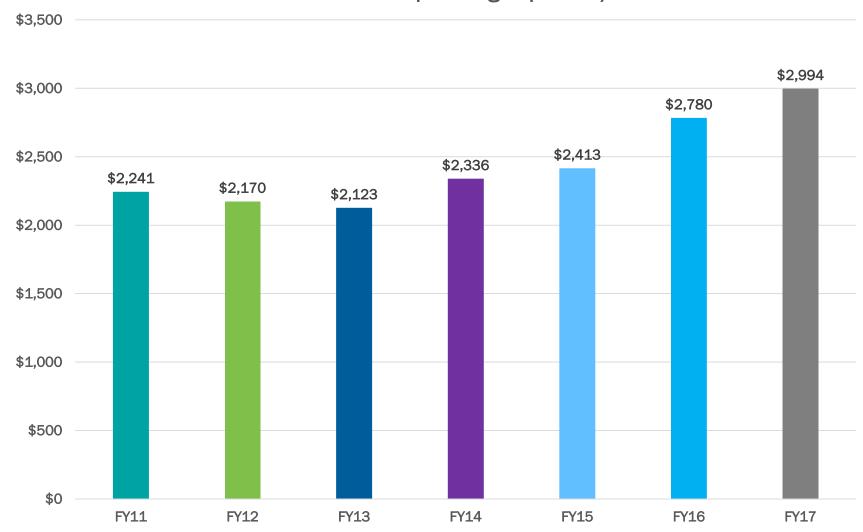
Spending on books & supplies generally increasing





Spending generally increasing

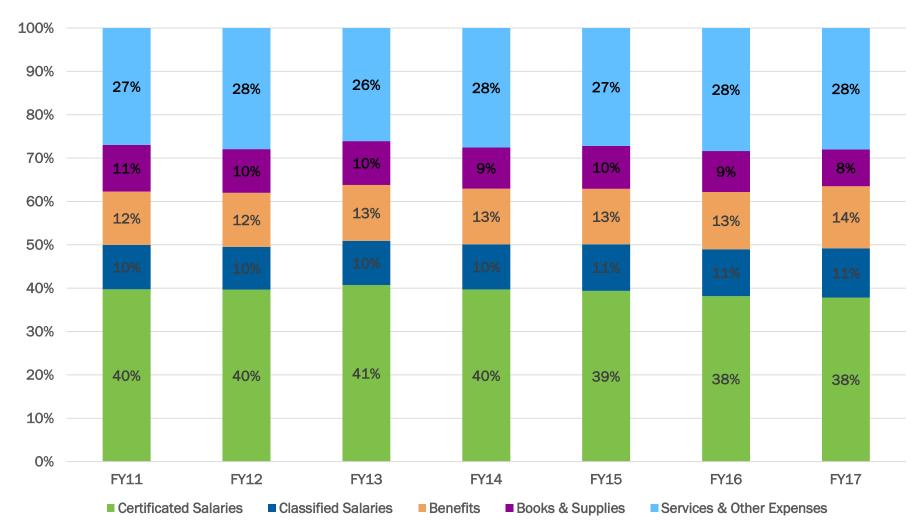
Services & Other Operating Expenses/ADA



Percentage of expenses over time



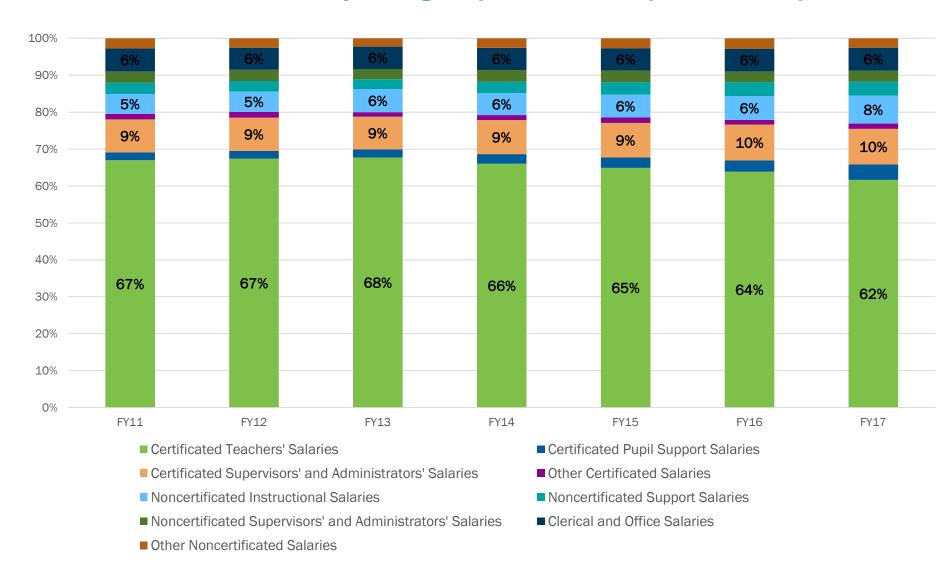
Expenses over time generally remains constant

Certificated teacher salary is largest portion of compensation expenditure

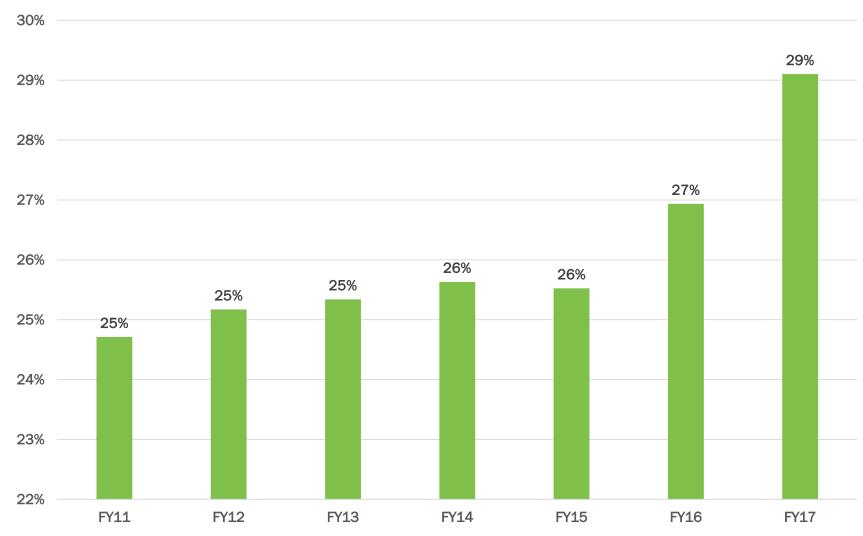


Benefits



Average charter spent on benefits as percentage of salaries increased to 29%



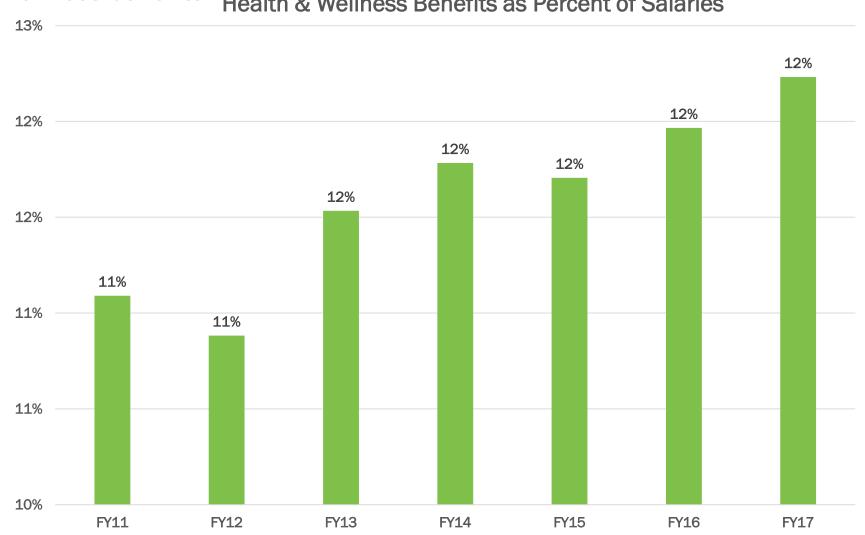


Health & Wellness Benefits

Health & Wellness Benefits as Percent of Salaries

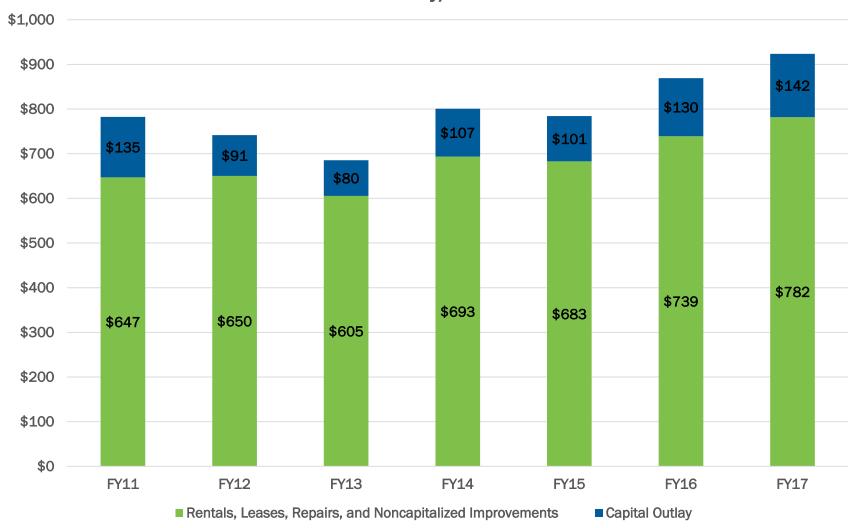


Facilities: 7-year trends

On average, negative operating incomes between FY13 - FY17

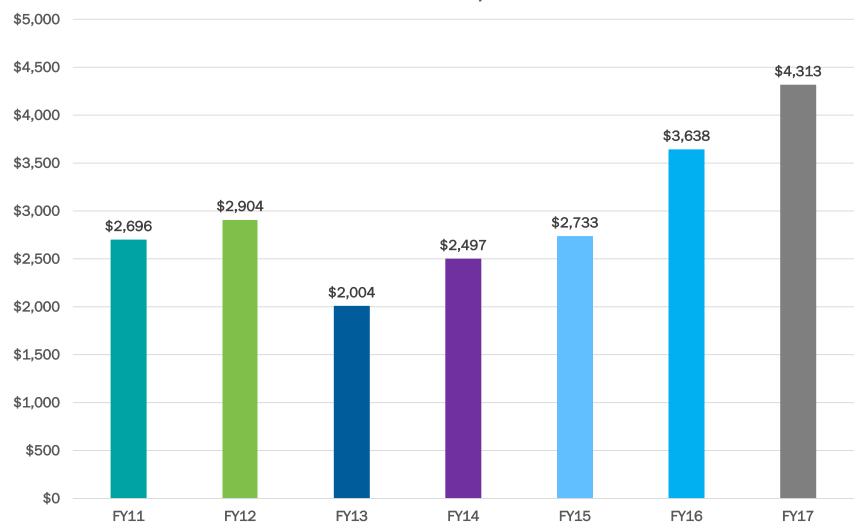


Fund Balance: 7-year trends

Decline in FY14, but general increase in assets

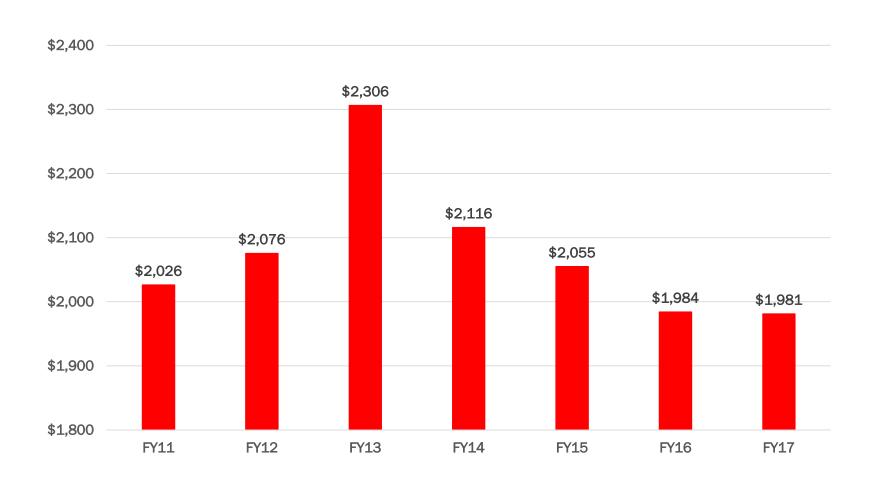


Liabilities: 7-year trends

- Include the operation manager or administrative assistant when working on the budget
- Share the final approved budget with staff at the beginning of school year
- Monitor & Evaluate

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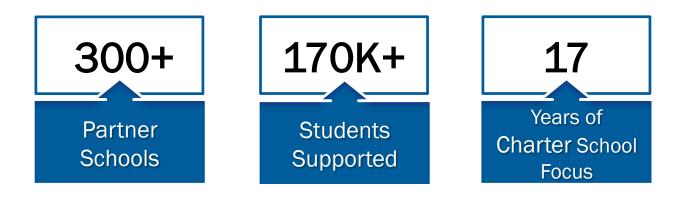
